RE: Lead content in products manufactured by Worzalla Publishing Company (WPC)

In response to the US Consumer Product Safety Improvement Act (CPSIA), which regulates lead content in children's products, WPC has established a "reasonable testing program". We have confirmed through our vendors / suppliers verifications and other industry testing that raw materials and components used in manufacturing books at the WPC facility contain:

- Less than 100 ppm of lead**

WPC hereby acknowledges that the final product that we supply to you may be used to create a children's product (as defined in the CPSIA of 2008). Accordingly, we hereby certify that all products that we supply to you from February 10, 2009 and afterwards shall comply with all applicable laws and regulations under the jurisdiction of the United States Consumer Product Safety Commission and shall not exceed 100 PPM for total lead content.

Testing completed by others in our industry, along with our vendors / suppliers, ensures that the products WPC uses are safe and comply with the CPSIA regulations.

WPC has and will continue to comply with all local, state and federal regulations and laws. As requirements change, WPC will continue to operate within those requirements.
